## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an emergency Constitutional amendment to the
- 2 Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania granting the
- 3 General Assembly the power to enact special laws to aid
- 4 certain individuals, corporations, associations, institutions
- or nonpublic schools adversely affected by conditions caused
- 6 by certain storms, floods or tornados.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby resolves as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Many Pennsylvanians have suffered greatly from
- 10 the ravages of great storms or floods in the last few years. The
- 11 great storms, floods or tornados of 1974, 1975 and 1976 are
- 12 additional major disasters causing loss of life and great damage
- 13 and destruction to property of individuals, industrial and
- 14 commercial establishments and public facilities.
- 15 It is imperative that the victims of these disasters
- 16 immediately receive the fullest possible aid from both the
- 17 public and private sectors in order to clean up and rebuild the
- 18 affected areas of the Commonwealth and that persons in the
- 19 Commonwealth be eligible for the maximum available aid from the
- 20 government of the United States.

- 1 The General Assembly desires to alleviate such storm or
- 2 economic deprivation caused by the floods and storms but is
- 3 limited in its efforts by rigid restrictions in the Constitution
- 4 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The safety and welfare of
- 5 the Commonwealth requires prompt amendment to the Constitution
- 6 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 7 The following amendment to the Constitution of the
- 8 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with the
- 9 emergency provisions contained in subsections (a) and (b) of
- 10 section 1 of Article XI thereof:
- 11 That section 17 of Article VIII of the Constitution of the
- 12 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania be amended to read:
- 13 § 17. Special emergency legislation.
- 14 Notwithstanding any provisions of this Constitution to the
- 15 contrary, the General Assembly shall have the authority to enact
- 16 laws providing for tax rebates, credits, exemptions, grants-in-
- 17 aid, State supplementations, or otherwise provide special
- 18 provisions for individuals, corporations, associations or
- 19 nonprofit institutions, including nonpublic schools (whether
- 20 sectarian or nonsectarian) in order to alleviate the danger,
- 21 damage, suffering or hardship faced by such individuals,
- 22 corporations, associations, institutions or nonpublic schools as
- 23 a result of Great Storms, [or] Floods or Tornados of September
- 24 1971, of June, 1972, [or] of 1974, [or] of 1975, or of July
- 25 1976.
- 26 Section 2. This proposed amendment shall be submitted by the
- 27 Secretary of the Commonwealth to the qualified electors of the
- 28 State at the municipal election to be held on November 2, 1977,
- 29 after the advertising requirements of subsection (a) of section
- 30 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of

1 Pennsylvania have been satisfied.
